

STAT LESSON PLAN for English-Language Learners

Work at the Dairy-Part 2/ Trabajar en una Lechería- Parte 2

Lesson Duration: 60-90 minutes

Standards (as needed or required):

Lesson Objectives:

- Student will be able to use the vocabulary of a dairy or farm.
 - El/la estudiante podrá usar el vocabulario de una lechería o una granja.
- Student will be able to communicate issues concerning a dairy or farm.
 - o El/la estudiante podrá comunicarse los asuntos de una lechería o una granja.

Materials Needed

- A laptop or other mobile device
- Photos of the different farm equipment and items in the milking parlor
- A vocabulary sheet
- A lesson sheet with vocabulary and images

NOTEL This lesson is Part 2 of a two-part lesson for Working at a Dairy.





Target Vocabulary

- Disinfect the milk parlor Desinfecte el salón de ordeño
- Take the cows into the milk parlor Lleve las vacas al salón de ordeño
- Put the milkers on the cows Ponga el ordeñador en las vacas
- Turn on the milkers Encienda los ordeñadores
- Turn off the milkers Apague los ordeñadores
- Use the disinfectant Utilice el desinfectante
- Use the chlorine Use el cloro
- Clean the pump Limpie la bomba
- Clean the filter Limpie el filtro
- Clean the hoses Limpie las mangueras
- Clean the milk tank Limpie el equipo de ordeño
- Use the iodine sprayer Use el rociador de yodo

The Farm Equipment/Los Equipos Agíicolas

- Crank the tractor Arrangue el tractor
- Drive the bulldozer Maneje el buldocer
- Move the cow trailer Mueva el tráiler de ganado
- Clean out the bailer Limpie la empacadora
- The grain is in the silo El grano está en el silo
- Use the scraper Utilize el rascador
- Raise the front end loader Levanta el cargador
- There is a problem with the manure pit Hay un problema con el pozo de estiércol

Lesson Instructions

Language Note: The following lessons are intended to be taught entirely in Spanish for beginning English Language Learners. If your students are more advanced, these same lessons can be taught using as much English as is appropriate.

Teach the vocabulary:

- O Distribute the vocabulary sheets. Use a large computer screen or the Quizlet flashcards to teach and elaborate on each vocabulary word in the Milk Parlor Section.
- O Have student practice saying the words after you. Then flip the screen for the Spanish (or other language) translation.
- Repeat the term and give feedback until the student closely mimics your pronunciation.
- Watch video about the milking room.

- O Use a large computer screen or the Quizlet flashcards to teach and elaborate on each vocabulary word in the Farm Equipment section.
- O Have student practice saying the words after you. Then flip the screen for the Spanish (or other language) translation.
- Repeat the term and give feedback until the student closely mimics your pronunciation.
- Have students practice with vocabulary matching game.

Extension Activity/Connections to Other Topics
